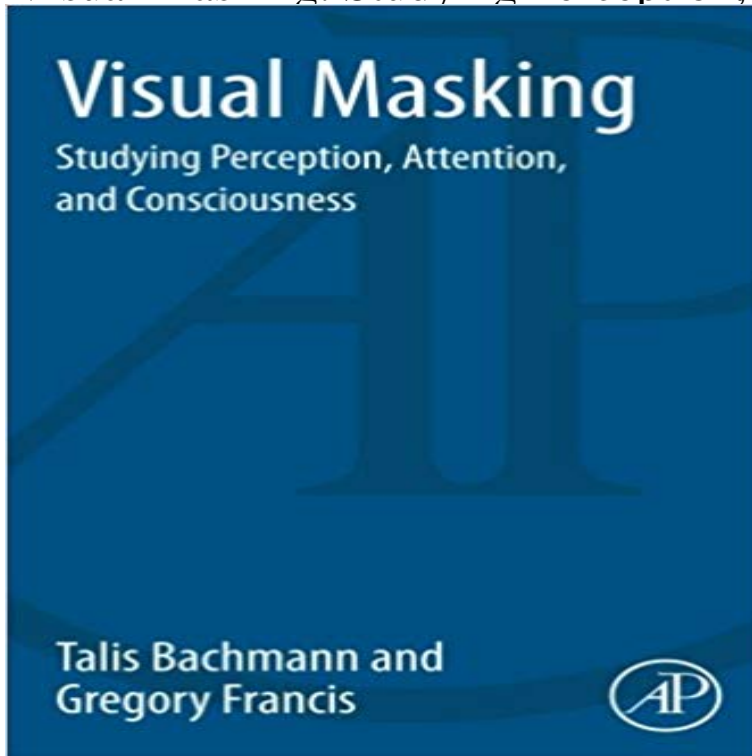


Visual Masking: Studying Perception, Attention, and Consciousness
