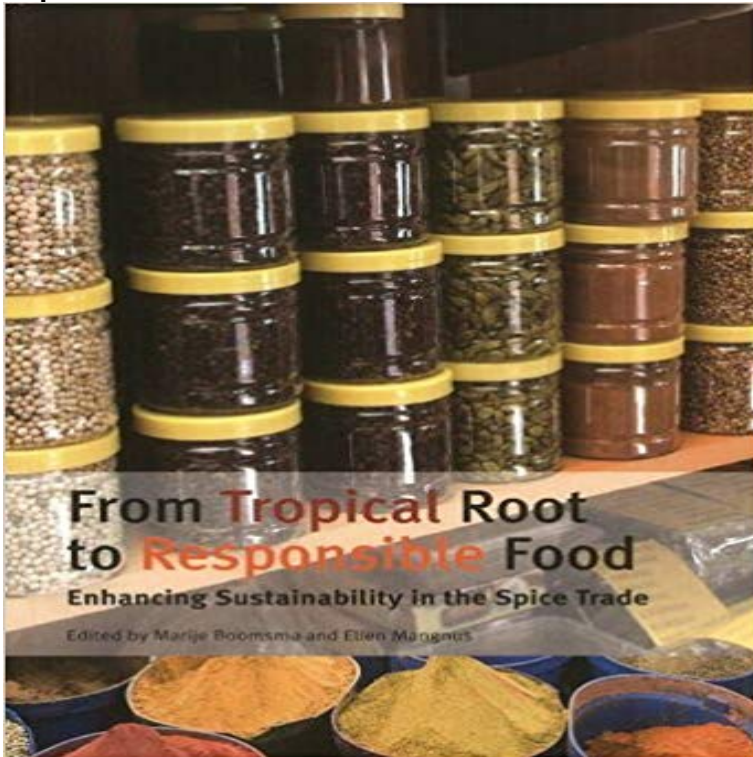


# From Tropical Root to Responsible Food: Enhancing Sustainability in the Spice Trade
