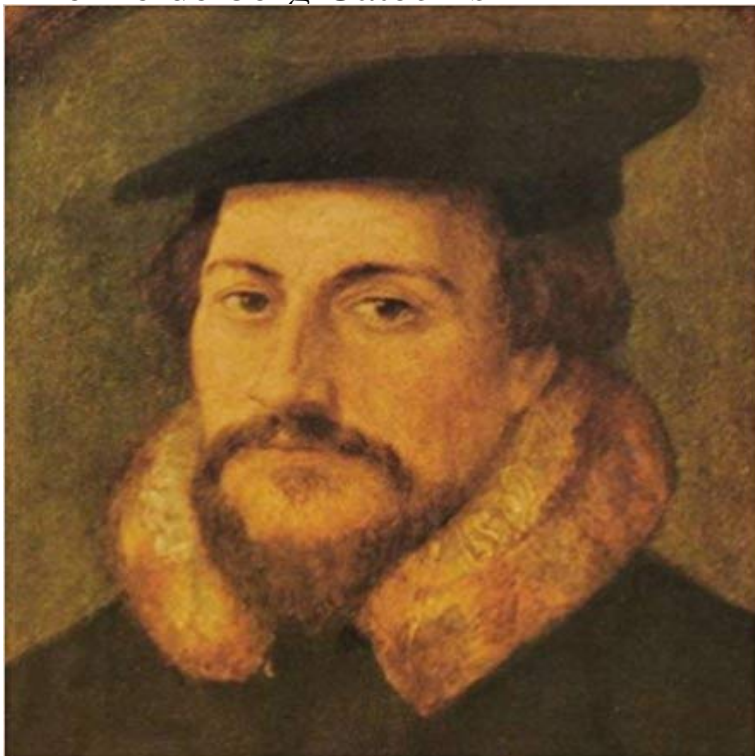


The Heidelberg Catechism



One of the symbolical books of the Reformed Church. Its name is derived from the city in which it was compiled and first printed. It is also sometimes styled the Palatinate Catechism, from the territory (the Palatinate) of the prince (Frederick III) under whose auspices it was prepared. The original German title (of the editio princeps) is Catechismus, oder Christlicher Unterricht, wie der in Kirchen und Schulen der Churfurstlichen Pfalz getrieben wirdt: Gedruckt in der Churfurstlichen Stad Heydelberg, dulrch Johannemr llayer, 1563 (Catechism, or Christian Instruction, according to the Usages of the Churches and Schools of the Electoral Palatinate).
