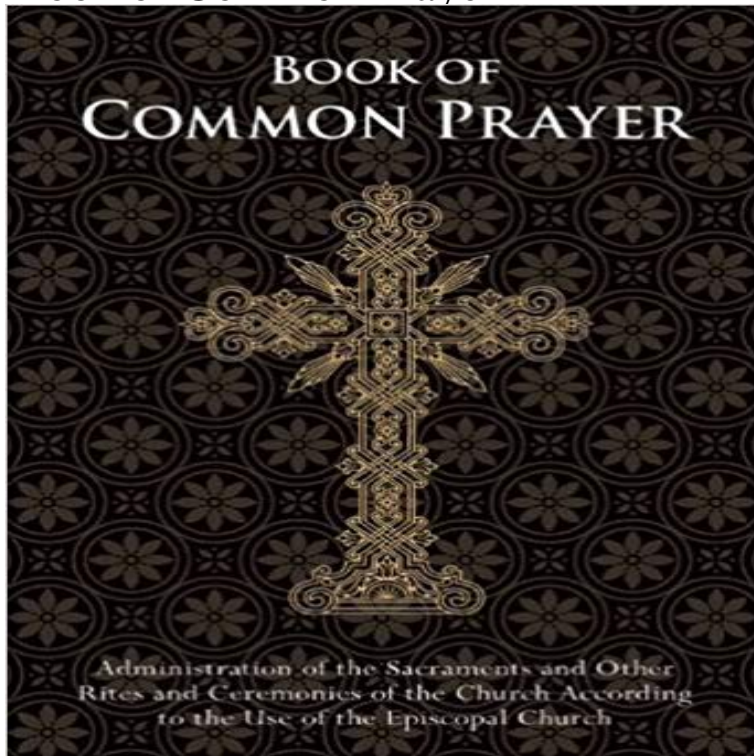


Book of Common Prayer
